A. Course Description

In this course, we will learn the basic *Koinē* (Κοινή) Greek grammar and syntax. We will learn the remainder of the non-indicative moods, like subjunctive, also verbs like participles, infinitive. We will also learn the key principles of translation, and more advanced grammatical concepts. Especially the students will try their best to do the exegesis practices for 50-100 familiar Scriptures.

B. Course Goal

- Learn the Basic New Testament Greek Grammar
- Learn the New Testament Greek Syntax
- Learn how to use apps for Greek to do exegesis on Scripture.
- Learn how to use Daniel Wallace's book: *Greek Grammar Beyond the Basics*.
- To practice exegesis on 50-100 familiar Scriptures.
