

## Graduate Certificate in Missions (20 credit units)

This Graduate Certificate is primarily intended for individuals with a Bachelor's degree (or equivalent) in any subject. It requires 20 credits and can be pursued as an individual academic award or as partial requirements of a Masters degree program. The student must meet the general admission requirements. Requirements for the graduate certificate are as follows:

Spirituality and Spiritual Growth	3
Missions in Biblical and Contemporary Perspectives	3
Cross-Cultural Communications	3
Church Planting	3
OT/NT Teaching Perspectives or Biblical Interpretation	3
Any Missions elective e.g. including Islam, Buddhist etc. focus	3
Practicum/s in Missions	2
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>20</b>

All courses run for 39 hours over approximately 13 weeks taught in English or bilingually in English and Mandarin

### Notes:

- The student must meet general admission requirements.
- The student may enter with, and must maintain, a 2.7 GPA.
- After the completion of 20 credits, with a minimum 2.7 GPA, the student may apply to transfer to a Masters program, provided they meet all the degree prerequisites, and have faculty approval.
- A student who completes the Graduate Certificate Program will receive 20 credits of advanced standing in any 41 credit ETS Masters level degree.
- Students who complete any Masters degree (including M.Div.) within two years of receiving a Graduate Certificate in Missions must surrender the Graduate Certificate before receiving their Master's degree.
