



# Master of Divinity

## I. Programme Design

MDiv is meant to equip church pastors. Students need to take 101 credits including prescribed practicum in order to complete the programme. For those MCM holders of ETS, they need to take additional 60 credits on top of the 41 credits from MCM in order to graduate from the MDiv programme.

## II. Goals

Primary goals for students in the MDiv degree programme include:

1. Grow in personal and spiritual maturity to serve as God's servant.
2. Develop skills to lead and pastor the congregation in the church.
3. Manifest skills in preaching, teaching, administrating, counseling, worship, evangelism and missions to equip the saints for ministry.
4. Demonstrate sensitivity in communicating the principles of the Christian faith and in their application in different cultural settings.
5. Seek to bring together the best in academic understanding and building up the church and the kingdom of God.

#### **IV. Graduation Requirements**

1. Completion of all course requirements with a passing grade for each course and an overall average grade of B- (average GPA 2.7) or above.
2. Completion of Thesis Paper with a Pass.
3. Submission of a recommendation letter from the practicum supervisor. As for full-time pastors, a reflection paper is required.
4. Demonstration of good conduct.
5. Payment of all course fees and any other fees incurred.
6. Faculty Council's recommendation to graduate for approval by the ETS Board of Governors.

#### **V. Duration of Study**

Students have up to a period of 10 years to complete their Master of Divinity.
